The drop off and collection procedures at different doors for different classes are in place for a reason—to protect your children. If your child has a temperature, new cough or loss of taste or smell please keep them at home and call the school office. Also if you have someone in your house hold who has the above Covid symptoms your child must also isolate and stay at home.

As parents/carers are aware you are expected to telephone every day your child is absent before 9.30am so please call **0121 675 3269** and **select option 2 OR option 3 to speak to someone directly.**

Parent Parking

The staff car park off of Wash lane (opposite the shops) is **NOT** for parent use for drop offs or collection of children.

There has been numerous uses of this by parents with several near misses of children running around unsupervised whilst parents chat.

Parents are expected to find appropriate parking (e.g. NOT across residential drive-ways) outside of school premises, entering the school via foot walking to the allocated drop off and collection point for each of your children at their allocated time slot.

Please also be aware of several near misses and obstructed views from parents parking their cars in inappropriate places e.g. the pavement opposite the shops on Wash Lane.

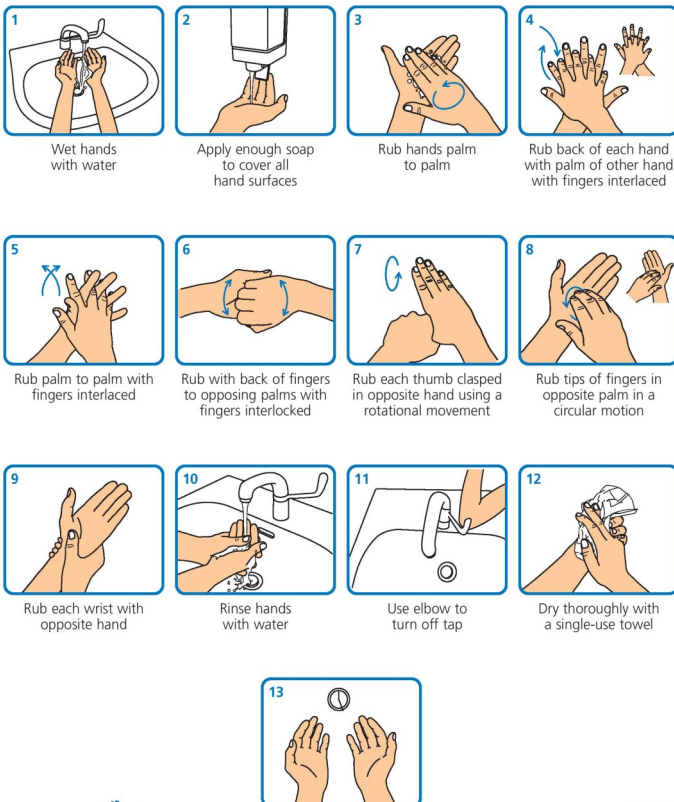
