As we enter this time of year when illnesses such as colds and coughs are common. If your child is unwell, please notify the office as early as possible in the morning, or you may send a message via Class Dojo.

ABSENCE FROM SCHOOL

Children are required by law to attend school 190 days per year. The Government states that every pupil's attendance should be at least 95%.

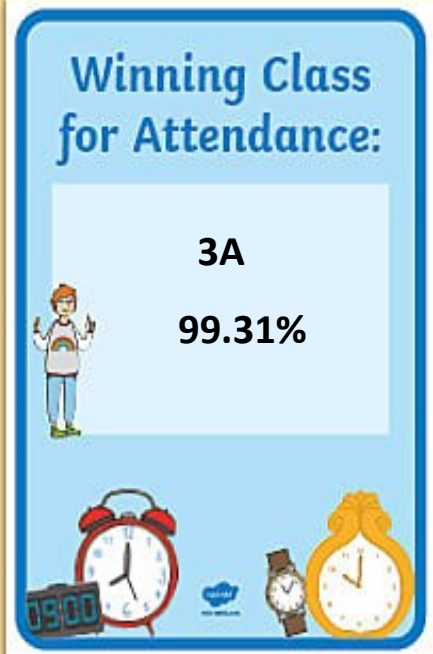

Reporting your child's absence

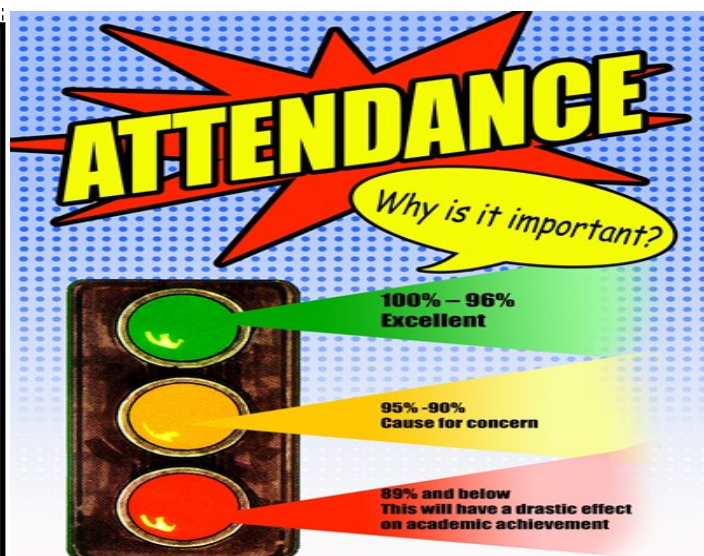
Please listen carefully to the options when you call and select accordingly.
