Thank you so much for contacting me recently with your concerns about road safety and Coventry Road in particular.

I share your worry – there have been too many accidents on that road that have seen people injured and killed. There are already average speed cameras in place that spot drivers breaking the speed limits.

I know that the council – who are responsible for roads in our area – are trying to do more and that they want to reduce the 40mph speed limit down to 30mph. I support this move, as it will make the road safer for everyone.

I will write to them on your behalf and ask if there are any other plans to improve road safety and I will let you know what they tell me.
